[Factors associated with childhood obesity]. Obesity is one of the most important public health problems in Spain, as well as in many other countries. Childhood obesity is a growing problem, and recent studies have identified risk factors associated with it. The objective of this study was to determine the factors associated with obesity in a sample of children from Barcelona (Spain). A transversal study was conducted using a multistage sampling design and data were obtained from a sample of 872 children (aged 8-11 years) attending primary schools. Weight and height were measured, and the body mass index (BMI) was calculated. A multiple logistic regression analysis was conducted to assess the factors associated with being overweight (BMI = 25-30), obese (BMI > 30) and very obese (BMI > 35). The proceeding of overweight and obese children was 37.4% and 20.3%, respectively, with boys being more overweight and obese than girls. The factors associated with being overweight (ORa: 2.29; 95% CI: 1.45-3.62) or obese (ORa: 3.09; 95% CI: 1.91-4.98) were, respectively, a high birth weight (> 4.0 kg), low age (older than 10 years), the presence of parents with a low education level (basic education or lower) or parents of a professional occupation, the existence of siblings and the number of hours of television per day.
