My son is a recent high school graduate who is going to university. He was diagnosed with ADHD after getting a C (class C) in the last school year because "he is incapable of concentrating". The criteria for diagnosis are listed in the DSM-V. Two of the 3 criteria are: 1. The presence of significant impairment in social, academic, or occupational functioning 2. There is a clear association between the impairment and one's school performance. In this case, the parent stated that reading required 3 to 4 hours to complete. So, the first part of the question is, does he qualify for a diagnosis? The second part of the question is, would such a diagnosis help with getting into college and following his studies? A: If one meets the criteria for ADHD (DSM-V, American Psychiatric Association, 2013), then that is not an indication of ADD.
